

We are really thankful to our National and International Donors. The feeling of contentment lies within us when we see the increasing number of donors both individuals and institutional who have helped and supported us in our cause. Grant Making


Grant Making has been the core work of Tewa since it was established. Tewa has been providing grants to the women's organizations who are working to change the status quo, transform their position of subjugation in their societies and who work for local peace building.

The aim of our grants is to transform the lives of the most marginalized and vulnerable women, to amplify their voices and make their concerns visible by strengthening movement building to advocate, engage and influence, and enhance their capacities through trainings, peer learning, and networking.

Tewa's grant making program has been initiated to uplift the socio-economic status of women and to establish their voice and visibility in the community.


This year as well we provided grants to 51 different women's organizations under 11 Grant Making Themes to support the initiatives of these organizations and develop their organization.

HERE IS TO STRONG WOMEN, MAY WE KNOW THEM, MAY WE BE THEM, MAY WE RAISE THEM

shwori Khadayak would have been in a been in a miserable state if Mahila Mukti Samaj hadn't helped her. Few years ago, Ishwori was impregnated by an Army Officer. Despite the fact that they had a special bond, the army officer refused to accept her and the baby because they were unmarried and later abandoned her. But with the support from Mahila Mukti Samaj, she was able to fight for herself and her baby. With the mutual understanding, the father of the child provides half of his salary to Ishwori. She invested the received money to open a small shop from which she is able to generate some income. Today, Ishwori is capable of supporting herself and her child.



Mahila Mukti Samaj is a women led organization established in 1995 with an aim to work towards the promotion of women and child's rights focusing on survivors of violence, and enhancing the sustainable livelihood of marginalized women. Women residing in this area are highly prone to various violences like domestic, sexual and not many people have their certificates of social registration like birth, death & marriage.

When the organization was established, it emphasized mainly on women who were survivors of violence. Mahila Mukti Samaj got its first grant through Tewa in 2009/2010 for advocacy and legal rights of women. Later when Rita Thapa, Founder of Tewa, Urmila Shrestha, Current Executive Director, Sadhana Shrestha, Former Executive Director & Former Employee Yelisha Sharma of Tewa visited this organization for Monitoring and Evaluation, Rita Thapa handed over NRs 2,000/- as a donation for the sustainability of the organization. It is the first organization in Dadeldhura to draw attention towards the issues of rights of vulnerable women and was doing great work at that time to support violence survivor women by providing counseling and legal support to them. The notion of endowment fund was started and the money was invested in the bank by opening a fixed deposit account. The concept was initiated with a view to cover the expenses from the interest received from the bank, for the sustainability of the organization.

Since the very first grant, the organization has brought numerous changes in the community. They have helped address the issues of violence against women and awareness on legal rights for women. Eventually, Mahila Mukti Samaj got the second grant from Tewa in 2014/015 for women

empowerment that included the activities of maintaining the safe house (built by local government bodies), leadership training for women and counselling for the survivors. The safe house on the other hand provides service to those who are victim of violence to provide them shelter and care. Since this organization was doing remarkable work, the local community people handed over the responsibilities of the safe house to this organization to look after it. When the safe house was commenced, it was started from a room due to lack of budget. But today, this organization has successfully built a separate safe house to provide specific care for the victims. From the starting phase till date the organization has already worked for 316 cases including rape cases, domestic violence cases, missing people case, polygamy and maximum of those cases were solved. About 68 women and 16 children have taken shelter in the safe house.

The recent grant was received in 2017/2018 for organization strengthening, and to enhance the capacity of the elected women representatives and legal counselling to the people staying at the safe house. The organization has been working on VAW since it's initiation and has a strong background to address women's political participation. The project that the organization is conducting is very relevant in the present context for the informed participation of elected women representatives in decision making. The organization will help women to draw the attention of the elected representatives to address the challenges faced by women including their political rights.

Grantee Capacity Building Training

rantee capacity building training not only capacitates the skills of our grantees but also strengthens the network among our grantee organizations by connecting them. Since 2008 we have regularly been conducting trainings on thematic areas covering different topics.

This year, we accomplished to conduct 11 grantee capacity building trainings both inside and outside Kathmandu valley for our grantee partners on various relevant topics that was much appreciated by them. 230 participants representing 70 organizations participated in the trainings.



L, M & E unit develops the framework through two methods i.e. Process Monitoring and Process Evaluation. This year we were successful to develop 22 frameworks through these two methods. We conducted site visits to evaluate and monitor the projects whereas when the site visit were not possible we developed the framework through extended phone calls.

The main outcome from these frameworks developed have been analyzed based on Tewa's three grant making goals (1. Support the initiatives of marginalized women, 2. Enhance decision making & leadership of women, 3. Strengthen movement building so that women can participate, advocate & influence politically), and a fourth category of enhancing the capacity of partners' organization.

Thriving despite the stumbling block

hulmaya Majhi is a local resident from Garkhira, Manthali, Ramechhap working as a resource person who provides training on weaving. She has become so empowered today that she can sustain herself and her family. Phulmaya lives with her family. Eldest among the children, Phulmaya had a lot of responsibilities while growing up. Since her family's main occupation was fishing and agriculture, she spent most of the time helping out her parents which is why she couldn't focus on her studies. She had just completed her SLC and was doing her high school level education. When the 2015 earthquake hit Nepal with 7.8 Richter scale, Ramechhap was one of the most affected districts. At the time of the Earthquake,

was Ramechhap. So, coming in contact with our volunteers, Phulmaya got an opportunity to participate in socio-economic empowerment training on weaving. The training lasted for 3 months. After the training, she started earning some money through weaving. Again, our volunteers organized another weaving training in collaboration with Department of Cottage and Small Industry that was 2 months long. Phulmava became more confident about her work. Slowly, she started weaving different materials. And today, Phulmaya has become a trainer of weaving clothes. She goes to different places apart from her home town and provides trainings to those people who are interested in learning. Also, she is invited to facilitate in socioeconomic empowerment projects. She normally facilitates 3 months long training program from which she earns in total of USD 600/-. These days, Phulmaya is mostly occupied in travelling to various places for trainings. But apart from this, she also supports her family in their family occupation.



Volunteers Mobilization

obilizing our volunteers is a two way support for both Tewa and our volunteers. Tewa engages local volunteers in different events, provides trainings and opportunities to advocate modern philanthropy and give back to the society. Whereas these volunteer trainings have provided the opportunities for our volunteers to contribute to the work that Tewa has been doing for women empowerment and to create an equitable and just society. Tewa organizes volunteers training twice a year. We trained 44 volunteers this year.

Apart from providing trainings, we also provide opportunities for our volunteers to partake in different other trainings to enhance their knowledge. Volunteers are like the gems of Tewa, because of their constant dedication, belief and support to every event. To appreciate our volunteers, volunteer's award is organized once a year. Till date, Tewa has trained and mobilized 764 Volunteers who actively support the work of Tewa.









Exposure Visit:

Together, Moving Forward

ewa organizes exposure visits to our grantee partner organizations twice a year for our volunteers so that they can directly know about the work our grantee partners are doing through the grant/s provided by us. The new batch of volunteers as well as the volunteers from 45th batch were given the opportunity to visit one of our grantee partner organization based in Kathmandu; EPSA (Entire Power in Social Action) is a non-governmental, non-profit organization which aims to improve the life of differently-abled people in the context of Nepal. With the motive of giving economic opportunities and creating a disabled friendly environment this organization has touched the lives of many women facing hardships because of their disability. This organization was established in April 2004 and has been working to enhance the capacity of differently abled people to empower them. The grant given by Tewa was utilized by the organization to support the members of EPSA to start small business for socio-economic empowerment.

Not only does EPSA provide vocational training to make beautiful handicraft items but also gives love, support and a shoulder to lean on to each other. They have not only helped the people economically but also created a family amongst one another who are going through similar situations in life. Before parting, the volunteers and staff couldn't help but buy the shoes, bags, decoration stuffs that they had to offer. Taking a small piece of EPSA home, the volunteers realized the support Tewa is making to empower the most marginalized and the vulnerable women of Nepal.

Children's Program

ewa initiated children's program in 2007 A.D. with a hope to develop the feeling of community philanthropy in children and also let them grow to become a sensible person. It provides a space for the community children to learn and enhance their personal growth. Tewa has been giving continuity to the ongoing weekly session on Saturday to expose the children to various knowledge and broaden their thinking from different aspects.

ne Billion Rising, OBR is celebrated on 14th February every year. It is a global movement where women, men come out on the street to show solidarity on Violence against Women. The "billion" refers to the UN statistic that one in three women will be

raped or beaten in her lifetime, or about one billion. The campaign expands each year. The theme for the campaign was "Solidarity" Rise, Resist, and Unite. The One Billion Rising gives civil society of Nepal a platform to celebrate women's strength and weakness through OBR celebration. Most importantly, it binds the core work of civil society working in the field of women empowerment and creates awareness in the general public.

Like last year, this year also we celebrated the OBR making it a huge success. Rallies from two different places - one from Lalitpur Metropolitan Office and another from Kathmandu Metropolitan Office was organized, which convened at Maitighar Mandala to attract the attention of government officials, Home Ministry office, among others which are located close by.

The rally chanted slogans demanding equal women participation in the Provincial states; demanding more women leaders in government bodies with equal rights; gender equality and ending the exploitation of women which was then followed by a group dance by young volunteers from Nepal Mahila Ekata Samaj who danced along with the OBR song.

A good coordination between 35 organizations of civil society was initiated to conduct the global campaign. The huge participation of more than 500 individuals spread the message of ending exploitation against women and putting efforts in ending violence against women in all forms.



Our Activities

A loose network of 11 grantee partner organizations was formed in Dhanusha called Janaki Mahila Sanjal. The main objective to form this network is to support women's groups through peer learning and regular meetings. Another way Tewa helps this network is by connecting them to different national level networks who are working in women issues especially focusing on child marriage and dowry system in the Terai region.

Strategic Planning Midterm Review Tewa's new strategic plan for 2014-2019 was

prepared by the Founder, Board & General members, staff and advisors under its Theory of Change framework. The mid-term review of the plan was done in January 2018.

Total of 7 volunteers and grantee partners participated in feminist training organized by Jagori Sangat: Jagori conducted 15 days course on Gender, Human Rights, Just Governance, Sustainable Development and Women's Empowerment.

MENTORSHIP PROGRAM:

After official closure of Shadow Barefoot Volunteers Program, we commenced mentorship program in 3 different districts Sindhupalchowk, Gorkha, and Ramechhap. We deployed 3 women from the Hamro Tewa Gaun Ghar (HTG) program for the mentorship of the women's group created during the HTG program. The mentors provide support, guidance, linkage, and help to enhance capacities of the women of these groups.


अनुदान कार्यक्रम





HERE IS TO STRONG WOMEN, MAY WE KNOW THEM, MAY WE BE THEM, MAY WE RAISE THEM

इश्वरी खडाएक अप्ठ्यारो अवस्थामा हुन्थिन् यदि महिला मुक्ति समाजले उनलाई सहयोग नगरिदिएको भए । इश्वरी एक अविवाहित महिला हुन् जसको प्रहरी पदमा भएका एक जना पुरूषसँगको निकटताबाट एक सन्तानको जन्म भयो । यसरी नजिकको सम्बन्ध हुदाँहुदै पनि त्यस ब्यक्ति आफ्नो जिम्मेवारीबाट पन्छियो । यसै कममा महिला मुक्ति समाजले उनलाई सहयोग स्वरूप त्यस ब्यक्तिसँग कुरा गर्ने वातावरण मिलाइदियो । फलस्वरूप त्यस ब्यक्तिले बच्चाको पालनपोषणको लागि आफ्नो तलबको आधा रकम दिने निर्णय गन्यो । इश्वरीले उक्त रकम सानो पसल खोल्न लगानी गरिन् । हाल यस पसलबाट नै आयआर्जन गरि आफू र आफ्नो बच्चाको जीविको पार्जन गरिरहेकी छिन् ।



सन् १९९५ सालमा स्थापना गरिएको महिला मुक्ति समाज महिलाद्वारा संचालित संस्था हो । यस संस्थाको मुख्य उदेश्य महिला तथा बालबालिकाहरूको हक अधिकारमा लड्नु हो । विशेषगरी यस संस्थाले हिंसा प्रभावित महिला र सिमान्तकृत महिलाहरूको जीविकोपार्जनलाई दिगो बनाउन काम गर्दछ । डडेल्धुरा जिल्लाका महिलाहरू विभिन्न हिंसा जस्तै घरेलु हिंसा, यौन हिंसाबाट प्रभावित छन् र उनीहरूसँग आवश्यक कानुनी कागजातहरू (जन्म दर्ता प्रमाणपत्र, नागरिकता, विवाह दर्ता) को अभाव देखिन्छ ।

स्थापना कालदेखि नै विशेषगरी यस संस्थाले समुदायका हिंसा प्रभावित महिलाहरूका लागि काम गर्दे आइरहेको छ । सन् २००९/१० सालमा महिलाको कानुनी अधिकार र वकालत सम्बन्धि कार्यक्रम संचालन गर्न यस संस्थाले टेवाबाट पहिलो अनुदान प्राप्त गरे । यो कार्यक्रम पि टेवाको संस्थापिका रीता थापा, हालको कार्यकारणी निर्देशक उर्मिला श्रेष्ठ, पूर्व कार्यकारणी निर्देशक साधना श्रेष्ठ र पूर्व कर्मचारी एलिसा शर्मा अध्ययन अनुगमनका लागि यस संस्थामा भ्रमण गर्न जानुभएको थियो । यस भ्रमणको समयमा टेवाको संस्थापिका रीता थापाले संस्थाको दिगोपनाका लागि रू. २०००/- सहयोग स्वरूप प्रदान गर्नुभएको थियो । डडेल्धुरा स्थित महिला मृक्ति समाज एक मात्र संस्था हो जसले अल्पसंख्यक महिलाको अधिकारको लागि आवाज उठाइ राखेको छ र हिंसामा परेका महिलाहरूका लागि कानुनी सहयोग दिंदै आइरहेको छ । आफ्नो संस्थाको दिगोपनाको लागि यस संस्थाले अक्षयकोषको शुरूवात गऱ्यो र त्यो पैसालाई बैकमा मुद्दती खातामा जम्मा गरियो । बैंकबाट आउने ब्याजबाट संस्थाको प्रशासनीक खर्चलाई धान्नका लागि यस धारणालाई अघि सारियो ।

टेवाको पहिलो अनुदान देखि अहिले सम्म यस संस्थाले समाजमा धेरै सकारात्मक परिवर्तनहरू ल्याएको छ । समुदायमा भइरहने महिला माथिको हिसालाई र महिलाको कानुनी अधिकारको बारेमा जनचेतना दिन यस संस्थाले मदत पुऱ्याएको छ । लगत्तै महिला मुक्ति समाजले सन २०१४/१५ सालमा टेवाबाट आफनो दोश्रो अनुदान प्राप्त गरे । जुन अनुदान स्थानीय सरकारद्धारा निर्माण गरिएको सेफ हाउसको मर्मत संभार र हिंसामा परेको महिलाहरूको नेतृत्व विकासका लागि तालिमको साथै काउन्सिलिङ प्रदान गर्ने जस्ता कार्यक्रमहरू संचालन गरिएको थियो । यस सेफ हाउसले हिंसामा परेका महिला तथा बालबालिकाका लागि बासस्थान र उनीहरूको हेरचाहको सुविधा उपलब्ध गराउँदै आइरहेको छ । यस संस्थाको अद्भुत काम देखेर समुदायका मानिसहरूले सेफ हाउसको जिम्मा यो संस्थालाई जिम्मेवारी दिइएको थियो । यस सेफ हाउसको शुरूवात एउटा सानो कोठाबाट भएको थियो । तर आज यो संस्था र समुदाय मिलेर सेफ हाउसको लागि छुट्टै भवनको निर्माण गरेको छ । महिला शसक्तिकरणको काम शुरू गरे देखि अहिले सम्म यस संस्थाले समाजमा आइपरेका समस्याहरू मध्ये ३१६ वटा समस्याहरू समाधान गरिसकेका छन् । जस अन्तर्गत बलात्कार, घरेलु हिंसा, मानिस हराएको, बहुविवाह जस्ता घटनाहरू थिए । हाल यस सेफ हाउसले ६८ महिलाहरू र १६ बालबालिकाहरूलाई बासस्थानको सुविधा दिएको छ ।

संस्थागत विकास र जनप्रतिनिधि महिलाहरूको क्षमता विकासका लागि र सेफ हाउसमा बसेका महिलाहरूका लागि कानुनी परामर्श प्रदान गर्न टेवाले सन् २०१७/१८ सालमा अर्को अनुदान दिएको थियो । यो परियोजना अहिलेको वर्तमान सन्दर्भको महिला प्रतिनिधिहरूको निर्णय लिन सक्ने क्षमतामा सम्बन्धित छ । यस संस्थाले महिलाहरूले सामना गरेका चुनौ तिहरूलाई सम्बोधन गर्नु र उनीहरूको राजनितिक अधिकार तर्फ जनप्रतिनिधि महिलाहरूको ध्यानाकर्षण गराउन महत गर्दछ ।

टेवाको क्षमता अभिबृद्दि कार्यक्रम निरन्तर रूपमा अधि बढिरहेको छ । यस क्षमता अभिबृद्दि कार्यक्रमले अनुदान प्राप्त महिलाहरूको क्षमताको विकास मात्र नगरि उनीहरू वीचको संबन्धलाई सवलीकरण पनि गर्दै आइरहेको छ । टेवाले सन् २००८ सालदेखि विभिन्न विषयमा क्षमता अभिबृद्दि तालिम नियमित रूपमा संचालन गर्दै आइरहेको छ ।

यस वर्ष टेवाले विभिन्न जिल्लाहरूमा ११ वटा क्षमता अभिबृद्दि तालिम संचालन गर्न सफल भएको छ । यस तालिमलाई टेवाको अनुदान प्राप्त महिलाहरूले निकै नै कदर गरिएको छ । जस अन्तर्गत ७० वटा महिला संस्थाहरूबाट २३० जना महिलाहरू सहभागी हुनुभएको थियो ।







अध्ययन, अनुगमन र मूल्याङ्कन निकायले दुई वटा ढाँचा (अनुगमन र मूल्याङ्कन) अपनाएर खाकाँहरू तयार पार्दछ । यस वर्ष हामीले १४ वटा संस्थाहरूको अध्ययन अनुगमन गरेको थियो । जस मध्ये १२ वटा संस्थाको अनुगमन/मूल्याङ्कन गर्न र २ वटा संस्थाहरूलाई अनुदान प्रदान गर्न अघि अवलोकन गर्ने उदेश्यले भ्रमण गरिएको थियो । परियोजनाको अनुगमन/मूल्याङ्कन गर्न हामीले अनुदान प्राप्त संस्थाहरूमा भ्रमण गन्यो र भ्रमण असंभव भएको स्थानहरूमा टेलिफोनको मार्फतबाट ढाँचा तयार पारेका थियो ।



यस ढाँचाबाट आएको नतिजालाई टेवाका अनुदान कार्यक्रमका ३ वटा लक्ष्यहरू (१. सबैभन्दा जोखिममा रहेका र सिमान्तकृत महिलाहरूको क्षमता सबलीकरण गर्नु, २. महिलाहरूको निर्णय लिन सक्ने क्षमता र नेतृत्व अभिवृद्धिलाई सहयोग गर्नु, ३. महिलाहरूलाई राजनीतिक रूपमा सहमागी हुन , वकालत गर्न र प्रभावित गर्न सबलीकरण गर्न सक्ने बनाउने) र चौथो वर्ग अनुदान प्राप्त संस्थाहरूको क्षमता अभिवृद्धिलाई विश्लेषण गर्दछ ।


बाधा अड्चनको बावजुद पनि आफु अधि बद्नु

गार्खिरा मन्थली रामेछापका फूलमाया माभी, होजेरी तालिमका प्रशिक्षक हुन । उनी आफैमा सशक्त भएर आर्थिक रूपमा आफु र आफ्नो परिवारको जिम्मेवारी लिन सक्ने भएकी छिन् । सामान्य परिवारको जेठी छोरी फुलमायाले बाल्यकालदेखि नै आफ्नो पारिवारिक पेशा, माछापालन र कृषिमा सहयोग गर्दै आइरहेकी छिन् । जब ई.स. २०१५ सालमा ७.८ रेक्टर स्केलको विनासकारी भुकम्प गयो, मुख्य प्रभावित जिल्ला मध्ये रामेछाप जिल्ला पनि एक हो । तब फूलमाया आफ्नो एसएलसी सकाएर उच्च माध्यामिक शिक्षामा अध्ययनरत थिइन् । भुकम्प पश्चात् उनको घर पूर्ण रूपमा भत्किएको थियो । यस घटनाले उनको जीवनमा ठूलो प्रभाव पाऱ्यो । उनी आफ् नो पढाईलाई विचैमा रोकेर आफ्नो परिवारको आर्थिक अवस्थालाई बलियो बनाउन लागी परिन ।



टेवाले स्वमंसेवीहरूको लागि वर्षको २ पटक अनुदान प्राप्त महिला संस्थामा भ्रमण आयोजना गर्दछ । यो भ्रमणको मुख्य उद्धेश्य, टेवाबाट अनुदान प्राप्त संस्थाले गरिरहेको कामको जानकारी दिनु हो । इप्सा (इन्टायर पावर इन सोसियल एक्सन) गैर सरकारी, गैर नाफा मुलक संस्था हो जुन काठमाडौंमा अवस्थित छ, जसको उद्धेश्य नेपालमा रहेका आपाङ्गता भएका मानिसहरूको अधिकारको लागि विभिन्न तहमा काम गर्नु हो । साथै आर्थिक अवसरहरूको लागि उत्प्रेरणा प्रदान गर्दै असक्षम मैत्री वातावरणका साथ महिलाहरूले असक्षमताका कारण भोगिरहेको अप्ठेरालाई छुनु हो ।

यो संस्था अप्रिल सन् २००४ मा स्थापना भएर क्षमता विकासको क्षेत्रमा भिन्न तरिकाले काम गरेर अपाङ्गता भएका मानिसहरूलाई शसक्तीकरण गराउन काम गर्दै आईरहेको छ । अनुदान प्राप्त रकमबाट इप्साले आफ्नो सदस्यहरूलाई स-साना व्यवसायको सुरूवात गर्न सहयोग गरेका थिए ।

उर्लदो सय करोड

उर्लदो सय करोड हरेक वर्षको १४ फेब्रुअरीमा मनाइने एक विश्वब्यापी अभियान हो । यस अभियानमा महिला पुरूष दुबै सडकमा आएर महिला माथि हुने हिसा विरूद्ध एकबद्धता देखाउने गर्दछन् । यूएनको तथ्याङ्क अनुसार "सय करोड" को अर्थ विश्वको कुल महिला जनसंख्या ३ करोड मध्ये १ करोड महिला (३ मध्ये १) आफ्नो जीवनकालमा शारिरीक तथा यौन हिसामा परेको देखिन्छ । यो अभियान प्रत्येक बर्ष ब्यापक रूपमा फैलिँदै गइरहेको छ । यस बर्षको नारा "एकबद्धता", "Solidarity" Rise, Resist, and Unite रहेको छ । यस उर्दलो सय करोड अभियानले नेपालका नागरिक समाजलाई महिलाका बिलयो पक्ष र कमजोरी पक्षलाई उजागर गर्न यस अभियान मार्फत प्रस्तुत गर्दछ । विशेषगरी यस अभियानले महिलाको सशक्तीकरणका लागि काम गर्दै आइरहेको संस्थाहरूलाई बाधिराखेको छ ।

गत बर्ष जस्तै, यस बर्ष पिन उर्लदो सय करोड अभियान भव्यताका साथ सफल पाऱ्यों । लिलतपुर र काठमाण्डो महानगरपालिकाबाट ऱ्यालीको शुरूवात गरि माइतीघर मण्डलामा समापन गरियो । यस स्थानमा भेला हुनुको मुख्य कारण वरिपरीका सरकारी कार्यालय तथा निकायहरूको ध्यानाकर्षण गर्नु हो ।

यस ऱ्यालीमा हरेक प्रदेशका महिलाहरूको समान सहभागिता, लैङ्गिक समानता, महिलामाथि हुने हिंसाको अन्त्यका लागि नारा लगाउदै वृहत रूपमा मानिसहरू सहभागी भएका थिए। त्यस पश्चात नेपाल महिला एकता समाजका युवा समाजसेवीहरूद्वारा उर्लदो सय करोड गीतमा नृत्य प्रदंशन गरियो।


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
